The Department of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine is delighted to make two announcements.

We would like to announce the appointment of **Alyssa Ziman, M.D.**, as Medical Director of the Clinical Laboratories for Ronald Reagan UCLA Medical Center. The UCLA Clinical Laboratories are one of the six largest in the nation, performing approximately 6 million laboratory tests per year, with the dedication of over 600 faculty, staff, and students. Dr. Ziman has been the Chief of the Division of Transfusion Medicine since 2010; in this role, she has worked collaboratively with clinical colleagues throughout the medical enterprise to improve transfusion practices and as a leader in the UC-wide blood utilization project. Dr. Ziman will be continuing in her role as Chief of Transfusion Medicine in addition to her new responsibilities.

We are also pleased to announce the appointment of **Sarah Dry, M.D.**, as Director of Anatomic Pathology and Chief of Surgical Pathology in the Department of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine. The division of Anatomic Pathology at UCLA receives over 32,000 surgical pathology cases, 43,000 Cytology cases, and 26,000 Cytogenetics cases, annually. Dr. Dry joined the faculty in 2000 and is active in the G.I., Bone and Soft Tissue, and Frozen Section Clinical Services. She is the founding Director of the Center for Pathology Research Services, an innovative UCLA institutional portal through which all researchers may access UCLA Healthcare human biospecimens and many pathology and lab research services. In her role as Director of Anatomic Pathology, she will focus on the integration of genomic medicine, telepathology, and Radiology-Pathology reporting.

Please join me in welcoming both Dr. Ziman and Dr. Dry to their new roles.

I thank Dr. Linda Baum, who has been appointed as an Associate Dean in the School of Medicine and Dr. Jonathan Said, who has been appointed Vice Chair for Research in the Department, for their years of dedication and many accomplishments in leading the Clinical Laboratories, and the Division of Anatomic Pathology.
